I am glad to comply with your recent request for information concerning my knowledge of Robert Pingpank, who is being considered for admittance to the Sixth Year Program.


Mr. Pingpank was a very successful mathematics teacher at Thomaston High School for more than five years. For the past three years he has served as the Department Head in mathematics.
