School Board To Get Reports

THOMASTON — A report on student elections and a planned program budget for math will be given today at the Board of Education Meeting at 7:30 p.m. in Room 113 in the high school.

Audrey Beachert and Walter Robinson will report on the elections, and the math program will be presented by Robert Pingpank.

Standing committee reports include the athletic council account, development of the budget for the 1974-75 school year, cost summary receipts and a meeting with the Board of Finance.

The maintenance committee will report on bid specifications for gutter work at the high school, use of a basement area at Grove Street School and summer repairs and maintenance.

Teacher-board contract negotiations will be summarized by the Personnel Policy Committee.

The Facilities and Coordinating Committee will report on a meeting with residents and a

trip to Hartford. The committee will also make a progress report on the High School Building Committee and on projected enrollment figures for the next school year.

Recommendations on the transportation contract will be made by the transportation committee, which will also list auxiliary transportation costs. It will also describe an inspection report of vehicles used to transport students.

Schools Supt. Marvin Yaffe will report on a teacher curriculum workshop, curriculum guides for the educable, mentally retarded, annual eyesight testing and grants for transportation and office education.

The board will also discuss full credit for the replacement of a boiler section at Grove Street School, track team jackets, dental exams and sales of industrial arts equipment.

Education bills before the state General Assembly will also be discussed.
