Episcopal priest to give lecture at Saint Jerome

"Hinduism and Christianity: Are Their Gods Identical?" is the topic on which the Rev. Richard T. Nolan, an Episcopal priest, will lecture Sunday at 7:30 p.m. in St. Jerome Church.

The public lecture is sponsored by the Adult Education Committee of the parish.

Father Nolan received his bachelor's degree from Trinity College; his master's at Hartford Seminary; a second master's at Yale and his doctorate in philosophy from New York University.

He is assistant professor of philosophy and history at Mat-tatuck Community College in Waterbury and has held teaching posts at Watkinson School, Cheshire Academy, Hartford Seminary and the choir school of St. John the Divine cathedral in New York.
